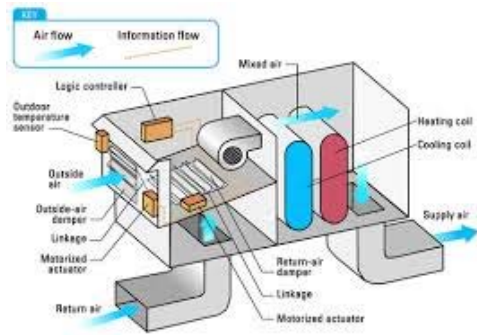

IU Optometry LARC & Optics Lab



Harrell-Fish is completing the first phase of the Fourth Floor project for Indiana University at IU Optometry. In this phase HFI installed a new air handler and condensing units for the LARC (Lab Animal Resource Center) area. The unique design of this unit included two separate air tunnels with 2 HW Coils, 2 CW Coils, and 2 Fans.

Air-side economizers HVAC can save energy in buildings by using cool outside air as a means of cooling the indoor space. When the temperature of the outside air is less than the temperature of the recirculated air, conditioning the outside air is more energy efficient than conditioning recirculated air. When the outside air is both sufficiently cool and sufficiently dry (depending on the climate) the amount of enthalpy in the air is acceptable and no additional conditioning of it is needed; this portion of the air-side economizer control scheme is called *free cooling*.

Good controls, and valves or dampers, as well as maintenance, are needed to ensure proper operation of the air- and water-side economizers.
