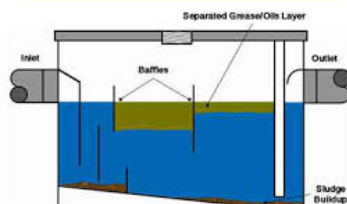
Grease Trap Cleaning

It's a dirty business - and HFI does it!



The grease traps are typically a concrete vault that is built into the wastewater piping and located below ground. Traps/Interceptors must be pumped out completely at least once every 90 days or more frequently as dictated by the 25% rule.

Account Manager Joe Kielar is working with the City of Bloomington on the Monroe County Energy Challenge (MCEC). Monroe County is a semi-finalist in a two-year competition to develop sustainable, energy-saving measures and hopefully take home the Georgetown University Energy Prize.

The "prize" is \$5 million which would be utilized for more energy programming, grants to businesses and residences for use in energy efficient projects. **Sustainability is the key.** "We want this prize to continue into the foreseeable future so we are still brainstorming how to make the prize money sustain itself long into the future," said Bloomington Sustainability coordinator, Jacqui Bauer during a recent interview.
